

## General Supplies for All Trinity Students

**These are the basic supplies, but some teachers may require additional supplies once class begins.**

- At orientation in August, each student will receive a student handbook/planner for their use in recording assignments.
- One **spiral notebook** and one **pocket folder for each course** (unless noted otherwise on list below)  
It is helpful if notebooks, folder, and binders (if required) are color coded for each course.
- Blue or black ballpoint pens (not erasable)
- Red ballpoint pen (not erasable)
- Pencils with erasers
- Colored pencils
- Colored markers
- Highlighters
- Loose-leaf paper, college-ruled for Grades 7-12 - replenish as needed.
- Dictionary: New College Edition: American Heritage  
or equivalent hardcover dictionary with approximately 200,000 words (electronic possible)
- Locker shelves (metal ones recommended)  
*please note lockers are narrow 16 1/2" deep, 11 3/4" wide with an 8 1/2" opening.*
- High school students are required to purchase the **Texas Instruments TI-84 Plus CE Graphing Calculator** from local retailers or online. The calculator will be used in **ALL** high school math and science courses.
